



Marylou Whitney Lends her Statues of Liberty

Shortly after the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks, **Marylou Whitney** and **John Henrikson** had twin Statues of Liberty placed between an American flag on the grounds of their Cady Hill House estate on Geyser Road in Saratoga Springs.

Photographer **Antonio Bucca** captured their patriotic display, which graced the inside back cover of the Winter 2001-2002 issue of ***Saratoga Living***, then called ***Saratoga County Living***.

Upon hearing that Bucca's photo of the twin Statues of Liberty was to be displayed at the **Brookside Museum**—as part of an exhibit on the tenth anniversary of 9/11—Whitney made arrangements for the statues to be transported to Ballston Spa, says **Ann Hauprich**, founder of the magazine. From September to mid-November, visitors could see the ladies of liberty standing guard just inside the museum entrance.
